FOIA - Release of Juvenile Offender Information Form

The Naugatuck PD is releasing information to you as a victim of a crime involving a juvenile.

Per Connecticut State Law, a "victim" is a (1) Person who is the victim of a delinquent act: (2) his or her legal representative; (3) a parent or guardian, if the person is a minor; or (4) a victim advocate.

Connecticut State law permits the Naugatuck PD to release the associated information which minimally includes:

- 1. The name and address of the juvenile involved;
- 2. The name and address of the juvenile parents or guardians;
- 3. Any charges pending against the child at the time of this request;
- 4. Information (if applicable) pertaining to the matter that relates to the delinquent act; and
- 5. (If applicable) any order entered by the court pertaining to the victim, including any "no Contact" order between the child and the victim.

Upon receiving this information, you agree that the information being provided will not be further disclosed or disseminated for any reason except for matters involving subsequent civil legal action for damages that may have resulted from the delinquent act.
