TEMPORARY STATE GUN PERMIT APPLICATION APPLICANT MUST BE TWENTY ONE (21) YEARS OLD APPLICANT CANNOT HAVE ANY FELONY CONVICTIONS TEMPORARY STATE PERMIT VALID FOR SIXTY DAYS

PLEASE FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS FOR OBTAINING A TEMPORARY STATE GUN PERMIT:

1. Fill out pistol permit application properly, clearly and have **NOTARIZED**.
2. Attach a **COPY** of your birth certificate or passport and a **COPY** of Firearm Safety & Use course certificate.
3. Fingerprints will be taken by Training Officer Marcus P. Jacoboski on a walk in basis on the following days.

Tuesdays 9:00 a.m.-12:00 p.m.

Thursdays 11:00 a.m.- 2:00 p.m.

4. When you come for your fingerprints, please bring your **notarized** copy of pistol permit application and **COPIES** of your birth certificate or passport and Firearm Safety & Use course certificate. Also include **COPY** of discharge paperwork from the U.S. Military(DD-214). Also if you are a naturalized citizen, you will need your naturalization papers.
5. Bring a Bank Check or Money Order for \$70.00 payable to the "**Borough of Naugatuck.**"
6. Bring a Bank Check or Money Order for \$70.00 payable to "**Treasurer, State of CT**"
7. Bring a Bank Check or Money Order for \$12.00 payable to "**Borough of Naugatuck**" (**Amount Changed October 1, 2016**)
8. Bring a Bank Check or Money Order for \$50.00 payable to "**Borough of Naugatuck**"

NOTE: No Personal Checks Will Be Accepted.

9. You will receive your temp permit in mail or email with in 8 weeks from date of fingerprints. Note some temp permits are before 8 weeks and some are after 8 weeks. If you are denied you will receive certified letter in mail explaining the denial.
10. Issuance of Five Year Permit: Within sixty (60) days of issuance of the temporary permit, you must go to Department of Public Safety Special Licensing Firearm Unit 1111 Country Club Road Middletown, CT 06457 to obtain your five year permit.
